

Magic of CHALO PARHO BARHO

LEARNING FOR SUSTAINABLE ACCESS

A two day training for an accelerated learning program of 50-60 days called Chalo Parho Barho (CPB) is an interactive opportunity to learn about a package of action-oriented methodologies, toolkits and resources that can boost learning for out of school and in-school children at risk ages 6-12 years. Combined Action for Maximized Learning (CAMAL) has been tested in 1500 locations in KP (Mardan & D I Khan) showing impressive learning gains for all children.

The training is structured to provide rigorous hands on orientation to practical methods that lead to accelerated learning in competencies such as, Literacy (reading, writing, listening, speaking) and Numeracy. Learning resources used in CPB are tailored for beneficiaries who are out of school drop-outs or never enrolled and grades 3-5 vulnerable children in schools. The program has already been extended to adolescent girls and boys addressing gender challenges. Learning material prepared for the CPB camps is mapped to National Curriculum 2006 and local contexts. It will be shared through practical activities that can be applied as teaching-learning accelerators. CPB comes with a monitoring app as well as baseline midline and endline assessment tools.

OBJECTIVES OF THE TWO DAY INTENSIVE ORIENTATION TRAINING

The methodology for trainees will be participatory including daily routines, whole class, group work and individual mastery skills with active learning on the floor /games demonstrations etc. The objectives are:

- To expose the participants to teaching-learning techniques and activities of CAMAL, to enable them to build basic reading and arithmetic skills - learning preparedness in children.
- To introduce modules including field implementation, assessment and monitoring of CPB
- To enable participants to completely adopt CPB/CAMAL methodology and facilitate them to work with a groups of children and adolescents with low learning levels.

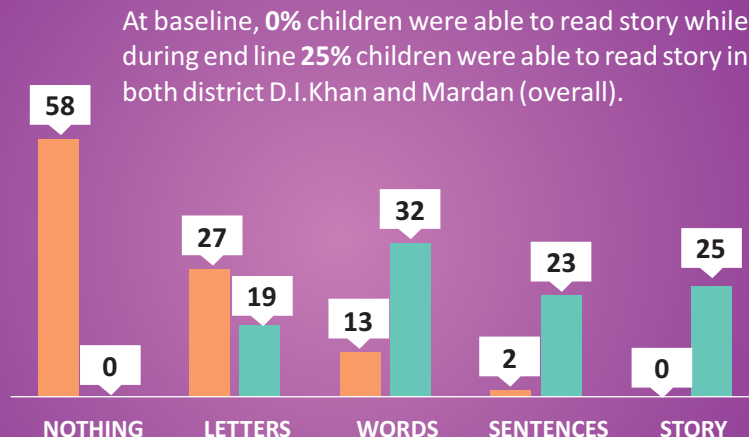
COST
